

2020 Accomplishments

Research and Reports:

- Conducted a review of all past Confidence Reports, prioritized updates and on path to publish update six.
- Analyzed the data from Run on Less Regional and published report on June 16, 2020.
- Collaborated with NREL and Ballard to publish reports after analyzing the Run on Less Regional routes for electric and hydrogen trucks.
- Launched new efforts to accelerate adoption of regional haul electric trucks with funds from the Hewlett and Climate Works Foundations.
 - Identify high-potential regional trucking routes – Math Challenge and Regions report published on August 24th.
 - Support implementation on first-mover routes – Continued promotion of success
 - Scale best practices in infrastructure deployment – Launched a Fleet Readiness Group
 - Increase confidence in the value of electrification – Led numerous workshops and webinars with a growing network.
- Planning to publish a dedicated Guidance Report on hydrogen fuel cell electric trucks in December 2020.

Industry Thought Leadership:

- Published “Defining Production”, a report on the definitions of being in production of a new truck model.
- Pivoted due to COVID to on-line leadership, maintaining the engagement numbers from 2019.
- Expanded networks and lead dialogue and debate throughout the industry in line with our research and organizational impact goals.

Recognition:

- NACFE awarded the Society of Automotive Engineers’ Environmental Excellence in Transportation Award for the 2017 Run on Less.
- Mike Roeth recognized to deliver the 2020 SAE Buckendale Lecture and manuscript.

Research and Reports:

- Finish updates of all review of all past Confidence Reports.
- Expand Annual Fleet Fuel Study increasing fleet participation while streamlining data acquisition and reporting process.
- Continue to accelerate the adoption of regional haul electric trucks via efforts in four distinct workstreams.
 - Identify high-potential regional trucking routes,
 - Support implementation on first-mover routes,
 - Scale best practices in infrastructure deployment and
 - Increase confidence in the value of electrification.
- Continue collaboration studies and issue reports with key leaders.
- Conduct research on deployment of Class 3-6 electric trucks in urban goods movement.
- Conduct research efforts on the evolution of automated driving.

Industry Thought Leadership:

- Conduct NACFE Workshops to accelerate learnings on electrification of regional haul.
- Conduct Run on Less 2021, potentially highlighting Electric Trucks.
- Explore helping the industry with sustainability accounting and reporting.
- Expand use of data collection and analysis in more efficient and sustainable goods movement.
- Lead dialogue and debate throughout the industry in line with our research and organizational impact goals.

Strategic Direction:

- Dramatically increase efforts in urban, final mile goods movement with our partner Rocky Mountain Institute
